These documents serve as a basis for verifying the appropriate use of the grant. 	

- Should the grant not be used as designated, it must be repaid immediately.
- The grant-holder consents to the forwarding of the application documents to the members of the jury, to the co-operation partner, to the accommodation provider (in case of artist-in-residence-scholarships), the organizer or to the Austrian Cultural Forum in Paris (in the case of applying for the Paris-Scholarship) and the platform www.away.co.at (© Bundesministerium für Kunst, Kultur öffentlicher Dienst und Sport).
- The applicant consents to the storage of first name, surname and date of birth in the "Prizes and grants" cultural database of the Province of Carinthia.
- In the case of occurrence of unforeseeable circumstances which exclude the possibility of travelling to artist-residence or necessitate a premature departure, the grant-holder undertakes to realize or continue the planned project as a home project.
- The applicant undertakes to abide by the conditions laid down in the Bundes-Behindertengleichstellungsgesetz [Federal Disability Equality Act] and the Kärntner Antidiskriminierungsgesetz [Carinthian anti-discrimination law], LGBl Nr. 63/2004 idgF (K-ADG), to plan and implement the project respecting the principles of equal treatment and in compliance with the rights of people with disabilities, and above all to design it as far as possible barrier-free.
- The grant-holder consents to the publication of the information relating to the award of the grant (see § 19 Abs. 1 K-FördG 2001) in the official culture report of the Province of Carinthia. Furthermore, in the realisation of the project, the grant-holder undertakes to display on all project documents, publications and specimen copies, and in the opening or closing credits of a film, the logo "Land Kärnten Kunst und Kultur" including the information that the project is funded by the Province of Carinthia. In the case of grants for photographers, the logo of the co-operation partner, "Landeshauptstadt Klagenfurt am Wörthersee, must be displayed on all documents.
- If you apply for an artist-in-residence scholarship, the scholarship recipient agrees to comply with the house and studio rules.
- Any disputes arising from this contractual relationship will be under the exclusive jurisdiction of the court at 9020 Klagenfurt am Wörthersee in accordance with § 104 JN.

Important information

- There is no legal entitlement to a grant.
- Applications which do not comply with the requirements of this grant, cannot be taken into account.
- If no submitted project is found to be eligible, the grant funds may be awarded for other purposes in the same category.
- Please note that no detailed verbal explanation of the jury's suggestions will be given.
- Projects already completed cannot be considered.
- The grant-holders are responsible for any tax payments that arise concerning the scholarship.
- Only one project submission will be accepted per call.
- Projects, for which a scholarship has already been granted by the State of Carinthia, cannot be submitted.
- Applications for scholarships for the creation or finalization of theses (bachelor's or master's theses or dissertations) are not possible.
- Travel expenses and costs for material will not be covered.
- The grant-holder is responsible to organize health and accident insurance for themselves.
- Compliance with house rules (in the case of applying for an artist-in-residence scholarship).
